Resounding Harmony
Presents Concert Benefiting Dallas CASA

Dallas, Texas, JUNE 27, 2015—Resounding Harmony, Dallas' only philanthropic chorus, presents a benefit concert for Dallas CASA at 7:30 p.m., Saturday June 27 at Dallas City Performance Hall, 2520 Flora Street.

The concert, entitled "Through the Eyes of a Child," will raise funds for Dallas CASA, a nonprofit organization that provides volunteer advocates for abused and neglected children living in protective care. The concert will also feature Gloria Campos, longtime anchor at WFAA and former host of Wednesday's Child, as the evening's emcee.

True to its mission of "give where you live," the 100-voice Resounding Harmony has raised more than \$200,000 for local charities in the last seven years. Dallas CASA will use funds raised from the concert to recruit and train more volunteers to serve the needs of abused and neglected children in Dallas County.

Every day in Dallas County, more than 2,000 children are living in protective custody waiting for the courts to decide where they can safely and permanently live. Dallas CASA trains and supervises volunteers to gather information and make recommendations so that judges can determine the best outcomes for these children. Currently, Dallas CASA can only serve about half of the abused children who need a volunteer advocate. But Dallas CASA plans to change that, with growth plans that will allow every abused child living in foster care in Dallas County a volunteer to advocate for their best interests.
