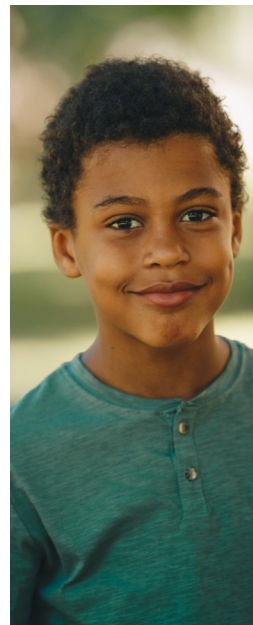

LETTER FROM THE CEO

Dear Friends of Dallas CASA,

The single certainty in the child welfare system is change. In 2017, the Texas Legislature mandated a transition to a privatized child welfare system model, to be rolled out on a region-by-region basis, with contractors selected in competitive bid processes. Perhaps foretelling the anticipated level of difficulty, EMPOWER was the only bidder that applied for the contractor role in the region that includes Dallas County. Our region’s transition impacted more children than in any Texas region that had previously transitioned to privatization. The initial stage of the transition in Dallas County, which involved recruiting and managing foster care placements, began in September 2023, with EMPOWER taking over case management responsibilities from Child Protective Services (CPS) on March 1, 2024.

Dallas CASA staff and volunteer advocates were prepared for their roles as the constant in the life of a child to matter more than ever during this transition. They knew their ability to communicate a family’s strengths and challenges to new EMPOWER caseworkers and to emphasize critical, upcoming deadlines and priorities, particularly those impacting child safety and permanency, would be essential.

The wildcard turned out to be the overwhelming workforce challenge EMPOWER faced, with far fewer than the expected number of tenured CPS caseworkers accepting its employment offers.

With EMPOWER’s inability to match the retirement and other attractive state employment benefits, a high number of

tenured CPS caseworkers moved to other state agency positions prior to the privatization transition date. Compounding the initial staffing challenges, many of the caseworkers EMPOWER first hired quickly resigned once they realized how the number of vacant positions would dramatically increase their caseloads.

With EMPOWER experiencing what its leadership has described as a near 100% caseworker turnover rate, and with new hires who had little, if any, child welfare experience, Dallas CASA stepped up to fill the gaps. We could not be prouder of Dallas CASA staff members and our volunteer advocates for the expanded roles and responsibilities they have taken on, so that the needs of children and families can continue to be met. During this critical juncture, we are particularly grateful to our supporters who have made it possible for Dallas CASA to sustain the capacity to accept court appointments to all children in Dallas County child welfare court cases. With the extraordinary challenges the ongoing transition has introduced, and the heightened importance of Dallas CASA’s role in that transition, we are more grateful than ever to be able to serve every child in need.

CHILDREN SERVED

Since we first began accepting 100% of court appointments in 2019, Dallas CASA has served more than 7,500 children with more than 2,800 volunteer advocates. The organization serves more children than any of the 900 independent CASA programs nationwide.

In 2024, Dallas CASA served 2,042 children with 1,009 assigned volunteers, with 211 new CASA volunteers sworn into service.

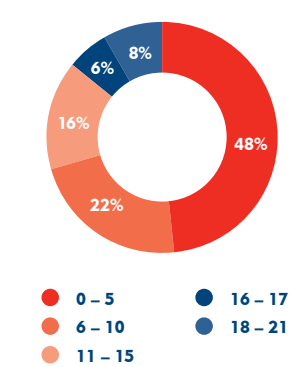
One meaningful indicator of a positive outcome in a child welfare case is the percentage of children in closed cases who are subsequently alleged to be victims again within one year of and five years after case closure. In Dallas County, where Dallas CASA accepts all court appointments to child welfare cases, a child was 5% less likely to be an alleged victim both within one year — and within five years — compared to state-wide averages. Compared with those of other urban counties in Texas, the recidivism rates for Dallas County children were as much as 12% lower at both the one-year and five-year marks.

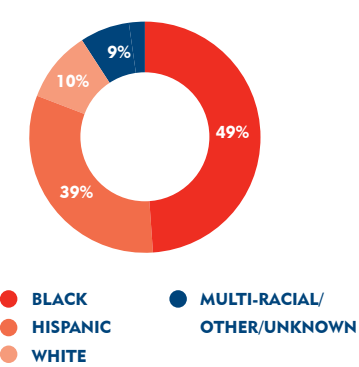


Of Dallas County children exiting the system in the state fiscal year 2024, 76% were reunified with family or placed permanently with relatives through legal guardianship or adoption.

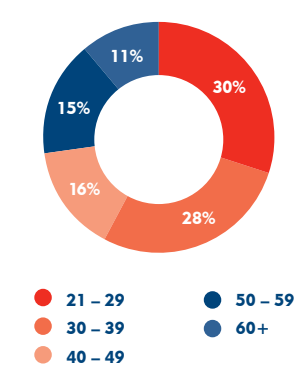
CHILDREN AND YOUTH BY AGES



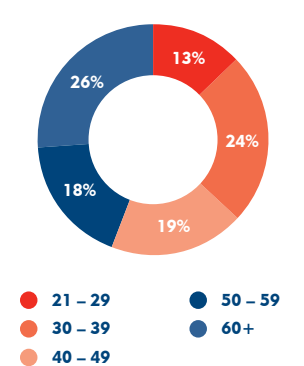
CHILDREN BY ETHNICITY

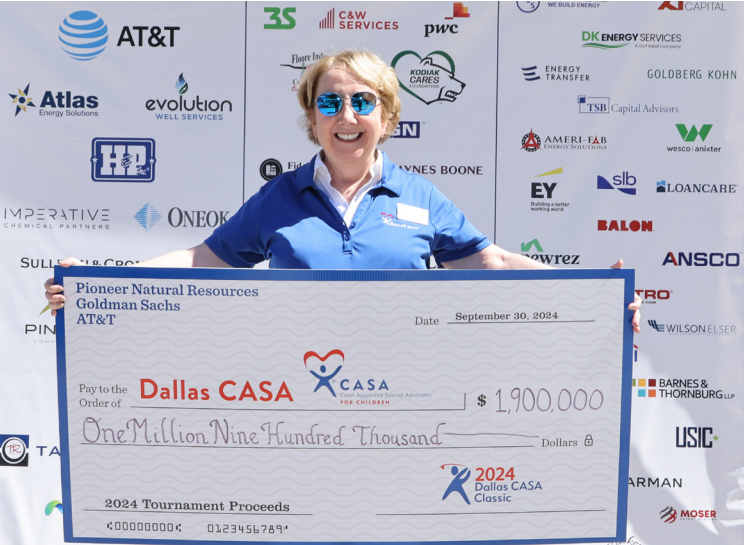

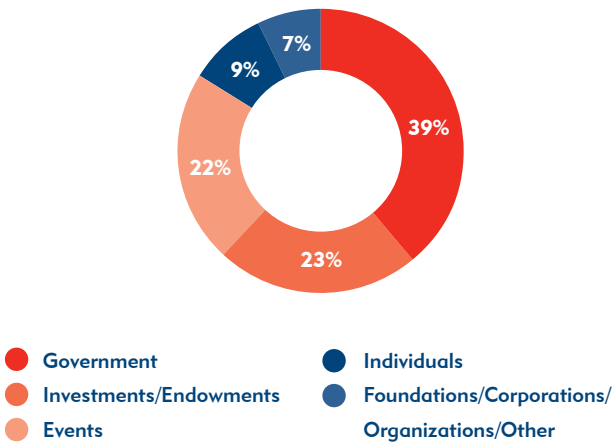

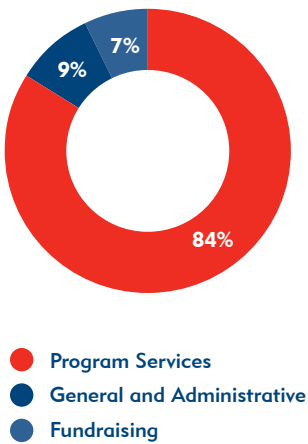
Total Revenue: **\$12.45** million Expenses: **\$9.3** million
